## ABOUT LEADERSHIP WEBSTER

#### Selection Criteria

Participation is open to all citizens residing and/or doing business in the Greater Minden area. The program targets individuals with diverse socio-economic backgrounds and seeks and racial and gender mix reflective of the population at large.

#### **Application Guidelines**

Incomplete applications will not be considered.

#### Selection Committee

Applications will be reviewed by a Selection Committee comprised of members of the Board of Directors, local business owners, and at least one past participant of the program.

#### **Program Tuition**

The Leadership Webster tuition is \$900 if paid in full at time of selection. Or, you have the option of two payments - \$500 up front with second payment of \$500 due in January 2025.

#### **Recognition**

Throughout the program, participants will be listed in news releases and articles which may appear in social media and printed medium highlighting the Leadership Webster program.

#### **Program Schedule**

The program begins in September with an orientation reception and ends with a graduation luncheon in May. Participants meet once each month and travel as a group to various locations throughout the community. Participants will also be required to attend meetings of various community groups including but not limited to the Minden City Council, the Webster Parish School Board, and the Webster Parish Police Jury. Sessions are usually the 2nd Wednesday of each month. The April session is a mandatory overnight, two-day visit to Baton Rouge. The program curriculum includes:

- Orientation/ Community History
- Simulated Society (SIMSOC)
- Education
- Economic Development
- Healthcare & Social Concerns
- Nonprofit & Civic Organizations
- Local Government & Public Safety
- Legislative Affairs

All sessions begin at 8:00am and end at 5:00pm.

### <u>Participant Responsibilities</u>

The Leadership Webster program consists of nine sessions scheduled in advance, beginning in September. Attendance at all sessions is expected. Participation in the orientation is mandatory, as well as at the community groups' meetings with no more than two absences in the remaining sessions. The mandatory two-day session in Baton Rouge coincides with the Louisiana Legislative Session, and those dates will be given to you as soon as it is scheduled. Participants not adhering to the attendance requirements will be automatically dropped from the program with no portion of the tuition refunded.

Participants selected to participate in the program will be notified by August 7th. Tuition due upon selection notification.
